

SEASONAL INFORMATION - JUNE

Crape myrtles may be sprouting from the root mass so keep this clutter pruned off if you are trying to 'tree form' your crape. New growth along the trunk and limbs may be taken off as it sprouts during the summer.

Birches and Maples should not be pruned until September. Birches will 'weep' a water-like fluid if pruned at the wrong time.

Hosta may be separated at this time. Please water generously throughout the summer.

Newly planted shrubs and trees should be deep root watered at least twice a week thru the summer and into the fall. A fast moving thunderstorm should not be counted as watering. Most of the water runs off too fast to soak into the root system
